## Call for Applications Deutschlandstipendium Scholarship Summer Semester 2019

The managing board of HdWM announces that **5 Deutschlandstipendien** will be awarded in the summer semester 2019, according to the German law for the creation of a national scholarship programme (StipG) and the HdWM charter. These will be awarded for the period from **April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020**. The monthly funding in this scholarship programme is 300€, of which half is contributed by a private donor and the other half by the Ministry of Education and Research. The scholarships are merit-based, but social criteria will be taken into account.

Students of all bachelor's and master's programmes at HdWM can apply, given that they haven't exceeded the regular period of study.

For your application, you need the following documents:

- Motivation letter (max. 1 page max)
- Current CV
- University entrance qualification
- Current transcript of records
- Certificate of a former degree programme (if applicable)
- Certificates of internships and work experience, as well as proofs of community service activities and/or prizes (if available)

You can hand in your applications **between March 15<sup>th</sup> and April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.

Please hand in your application **in paper** (punched with a flexi fastener; without folder or sheet protectors, with the notation "z. Hd. von Herrn Jürgen Kaufmann"). To turn it in, please use the mail box in front of the study office. Applications can only be considered if they contain all requested documents and if they are handed in in due form and time. It is not possible to hand in single documents later.

The stipendiaries will be selected by a special HdWM committee. All applicants will be informed **via email about the result** of their application.

**Please note: Exclusion of Double Funding (according to § 4 StipG)**

The funding cannot be granted to applicants who already receive a merit-based scholarship. This can either be by gifted support programmes, by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), the Stiftung Begabtenförderung, or any other domestic or foreign institution. If the funding for the allotted semester does not exceed the amount of 30€, it is not regarded as a double funding.
